

THE SANTA CLAUS TOWN COUNCIL NOTICE OF EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Santa Claus Town Board of Spencer, County, Indiana will meet in an executive session on the **9th** of **April, 2026** at **4:00 pm**. The meeting will take place at the Santa Claus Town Hall located at 90 N Holiday Blvd Santa Claus, In 47579 Indiana Open door Law- Board meetings are governed by the Open-Door Law, IC 5-14-1.5. Under the Open Door Law meetings of the governing boards must be open to the public except for Executive Sessions.

The governing body named above will conduct an executive session pursuant to IC 5-14-1.5-6 (b) for the following reason (s): check marked by the circumstances under which an executive session may be held, including the following:

- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(1) Where authorized by federal or state statute.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2) For discussion of strategy with respect to any of the following:
 - (A) Collective bargaining.
 - (B) Initiation of litigation or litigation that is either pending or has been threatened specifically in writing. As used in this clause, "litigation" includes any judicial action or administrative law proceeding under federal or state law.
 - (C) The implementation of security systems.
 - (D) A real property transaction including a purchase; a lease as lessor; a lease as lessee; a transfer; an exchange; or, a sale; by the governing body up to the time a contract or option is executed by the parties.
 - (E) School consolidation.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(3) For discussion of the assessment, design, and implementation of school safety and security measures, plans, and systems.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(4) Interviews and negotiations with industrial or commercial prospects or agents of industrial or commercial prospects by an economic development commission or a governing body of a political subdivision.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(5) **To receive information about and interview prospective employees.**
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(6) With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction:
 - (A) to receive information concerning the individual's alleged misconduct; and
 - (B) to discuss, before a determination, the individual's status as an employee, a student, or an independent contractor who is:
 - (i) a physician; or
 - (ii) a school bus driver.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(7) For discussion of records classified as confidential by state or federal statute.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(9) To discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees. This subdivision does not apply to a discussion of the salary, compensation, or benefits of employees during a budget process.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(10) When considering the appointment of a public official, to do the following:
 - (A) Develop a list of prospective appointees.
 - (B) Consider applications.
 - (C) Make one (1) initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(12) To prepare or score examinations used in issuing licenses, certificates, permits, or registrations under IC 25.
- IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(13) To discuss information and intelligence intended to prevent, mitigate, or respond to the threat of terrorism.
